Perched on a promontory between Narbonne and Béziers, Ensérune takes visitors on a journey through time and civilisations, from Celtic and Greek to Iberian, Etruscan and Roman.

The recently renovated and modernised museum offers an insight into this major fortified Celtic settlement in the south of France. The fruit of a century's worth of excavations, the collections on display bear witness to the strategic, commercial and cultural roles that the oppidum played over the course of history. The wooded surroundings, meanwhile, are the perfect place to get an up-close look at the living quarters as you soak up the

Mediterranean ambience and enjoy superb panoramic views spanning from the Cévennes to the Pyrenees.

DID YOU KNOW...?

The site is home to many cypress trees planted in previously excavated and emptied silos subsequently backfilled with earth. A cypress tree has been planted in each of them to indicate their exact locations.

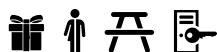
